2025 Canada Games Team Application Form

"The 2025 Canada Games invites Canadians to come and connect through friendship, sport, adventure and the experience that is Newfoundland and Labrador."

Over 4,000 athletes, coaches, and managers will compete for their provinces and territories representing their sports. We look forward to the privilege and responsibility of picking up the torch from past Canada Games that have so successfully represented our province.

The Canada Games showcase the best of the best in sport and highlight the immense talents of our youth. The Games create a spirit of unity that spans each province and territory. People connect in ways that go beyond the field of play, forming bonds that are deeply rooted in friendship and a collective passion for amateur sport in Canada.

For the Canada Games 2025, sailors from around the country will compete in;

- Under 21 Men's category
 - Single-handed ILCA 6: 1 competitor per boat (individual competition)
 - o Double handed 29er: 2 competitors per boat (team competition)
- Under 21 Women's category
 - Single-handed ILCA 6: 1 competitor per boat (individual competition)
 - o Double handed 29er: 2 competitors per boat (team competition)

Team Saskatchewan is aiming to enter sailors in each class.

The format of the Canada Games is an 8 - 12 race regatta with 1 boat per province per class. The Canada Games mimics the Olympic Games. There are selection trials, measurement, drug testing and education, an athlete village, athletes competing in other sports, team uniforms and pins.

The actual regatta will be small fleets of 10 boats or less. Ontario, Quebec, Nova Scotia, BC and New Brunswick are traditionally the strong teams in Sailing. Alberta and Manitoba are Teams more comparable to Saskatchewan. SK is usually finishing slightly behind or slightly ahead of Alberta and Manitoba on the results sheet and in the Canada Games flag points. Occasionally SK has finished ahead of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Quebec.

Since it's inception back in 1989, Saskatchewan has a history of competing in the Canada Games. Throughout the years Team Saskatchewan has been on the podium many times, has produced many competitive sailors, and always been a respectable team.
